## Gastronomy


Of course eating a Bouillabaisse is a pleasure. But cooking it with locals is even more inspiring


The Restaurant "Le Miramar", located on the quays of the Old Port, the heart of Marseille, is offering bouillabaisse classes with local chefs

Cook and sprinkle with a fresh white wine from Cassis, a neighboring village – amazing!




















# **Wine Capital**

La Cité du Vin – the new museum is an excellent example, offering a unique experience in terms of both its architecture and its fascinating exhibits




### New accomodations

The **Central Hostel** youth hostel recently opened in the centre of town, with a restaurant that is also open to the public.




# **Foodie City**

The new 'La Boca', offering a food court-style experience with fifteen independent restaurants.





### **Harbour Life**

Coming this year: **Marine and Maritime Museum** is dedicated to historical, scientific and cultural aspects of the maritime world.





































## Highlight: Hôtel du Palais

Now under **Hyatt management** with renovations completed by summer 2019 and the G7 meeting at the end of August

With 5 stars, palace category and Living Heritage Label, the Hôtel du Palais is one of the strongest icons of Biarritz since 1854.

A former imperial residence of Napoleon III and Eugénie de Montijo this Second Empire building is still owned by the City of Biarritz

The 2019 ISA World Longboard Surfing Championship (WLSC), set to take place at **Côte des Basques from May 26 - June 2** 


Just two years after the ISA World Surfing Games Biarritz **host another major event** at the cradle of French and European surfing: Côte de Basques

Team World Championship Trophy


































